DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

Show site is Winnegamie Dog Club Training Center, 7245 Manitowoc Rd., Menasha, WI. Menasha is located near Appleton, WI.

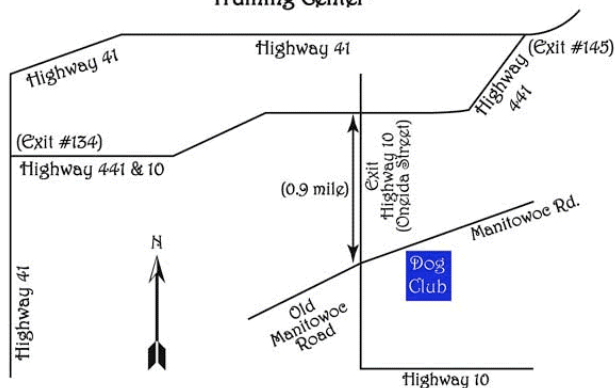
From South: I-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx. 30 miles to Menasha. At stoplights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd.) turn right. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From South (alternate route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge right over large bridge. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From West: Hwy 10 East. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From North or East: Hwy 41 to Exit 145 (Hwy 441). Exit Oneida St, turn left. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

SETUP

The show site has ample grooming space. Setup of equipment will be permitted from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm on Friday, November 2, but MAY be available earlier pending site setup completion by Club. The building will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday. Dogs are NOT permitted in the building overnight.

IMPORTANT: Tarps are required under your grooming area. If you do not have a tarp, a limited number of tarps will be available for purchase.

SEMINAR (Saturday, November 3)

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Show hours are 7:00 am to 5:00 pm.
2. Owners and owners' agents are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, except as provided for in AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
3. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, or other acts beyond the control of the club, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, lightning, extreme heat or cold, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
4. Dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
5. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club. Exhibitors are required to keep their areas clean. No grooming tables in the show area.
6. No private exercise pens are allowed inside the show building.
7. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or owners' agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the proper time. The club is not obligated to provide any service for notifying exhibitors of judging.
8. The show giving club and facilities owner, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, their children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Children are expected to be under the control of their parents or guardian.
9. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show. Only dogs that are AKC eligible are allowed on the show grounds.
10. All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. If not claimed, they revert back to the property of the club. No trophies will be mailed. The show giving club reserves the right to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value. Cash prizes will be presented to the handler of the dog.
11. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
12. All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their dogs!
13. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
