SWEEPSTAKES

All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered and exhibited in one of the regular classes at the show. Mark "Sweepstakes" and the age class in the Additional Class box of the entry form. A fee of \$10.00 must be sent with the regular entry fee to the Show Secretary. The Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular classes. Classes, with both Rough and Smooth varieties competing in the same class, will be as follows:

Puppy Dogs, 6 months & under 9 months	Puppy Bitches, 6 months & under 9 months
Puppy Dogs, 9 months & under 12 months	Puppy Bitches, 9 months & under 12 months
Dogs, 12 months & under 18 months	Bitches, 12 months & under 18 months

The first place puppy from each of the six classes shall compete in a Winners class for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. Runner-Up shall be awarded to the second best puppy, irrespective of sex.

DIVISION OF STAKE

Northern Wisconsin Collie Club, Inc. will retain 35% of the total entry fees for expenses. The remainder of the stake shall be divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes - 75% of the remaining stake

Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes - 25% of the remaining stake

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP ~ SATURDAY ONLY

Novice & Open – note that the classes will **NOT** be divided by age divisions

Note: AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC – Phone 919-233-9767

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

(Note: Neither GPS devices nor websites for mapping have the correct directions; please use the directions below)

Show site is Winnegamie Dog Club, 2043 Manitowoc Rd., Menasha, WI. Menasha is located near Appleton, WI.

From South: I-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx. 30 miles to Menasha. At stoplights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd.) turn right. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From South (alternate route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge right over large bridge. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

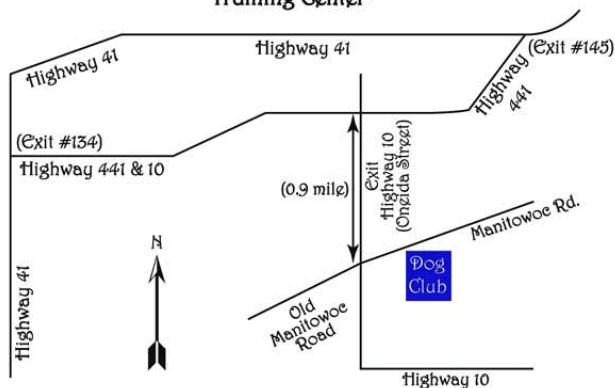
From West: Hwy 10 East. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From North or East: Hwy 41 to Exit 145 (Hwy 441). Exit Oneida St, turn left. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Show hours are 7:30 am to 5:00 pm.
2. Conditional, unsigned, or incomplete entries or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Telephone or telegraph entries are not acceptable. All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies must include front and back of official AKC entry form.
3. All entries must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. institutions or with International Money Orders in U.S. funds. Credit cards cannot be accepted.
4. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$10.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.
5. Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations must be received in writing or by telegram prior to the closing of entries, and must include AKC number of dog. Those received by telephone or email are not acceptable. Substitutions require a new completed entry form.
6. Owners and owners' agents are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, except as provided for in AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
7. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, or other acts beyond the control of the club, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, lightning, extreme heat or cold, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
8. Dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
9. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club. Exhibitors are required to keep their areas clean. No grooming tables in the show area.
10. No private exercise pens are allowed inside the show building.
11. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or owners' agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the proper time. The club is not obligated to provide any service for notifying exhibitors of judging.
12. The show giving club and facilities owner, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, their children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Children are expected to be under the control of their parents or guardian.
13. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show. Only dogs that are AKC eligible are allowed on the show grounds.
14. All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. If not claimed, they revert back to the property of the club. No trophies will be mailed. The show giving club reserves the right to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value. Cash prizes will be presented to the handler of the dog.
15. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
16. All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their dogs!
17. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in the premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
