SWEEPSTAKES – Saturday AM ONLY Specialty

All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered and exhibited in one of the regular classes at the show. Mark "Sweepstakes" and the age class in the Additional Class box of the entry form. A fee of \$5.00 must be sent with the regular entry fee to the Show Secretary. The Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular classes. Classes, with both Rough and Smooth varieties competing in the same class, will be as follows:

Puppy Dogs, 6 months & under 9 months	Puppy Bitches, 6 months & under 9 months
Puppy Dogs, 9 months & under 12 months	Puppy Bitches, 9 months & under 12 months
Dogs, 12 months & under 18 months	Bitches, 12 months & under 18 months

The first place puppy from each of the six classes shall compete in a Winners class for Best in Sweepstakes and Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes. Runner-Up shall be awarded to the second best puppy, irrespective of sex.

DIVISION OF STAKE (ROUNDED TO NEAREST DOLLAR)

Northern Wisconsin Collie Club, Inc. will retain 35% of the total entry fees for expenses. The remainder of the stake shall be divided as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes - 75% of the remaining stake

Runner-Up to Best in Sweepstakes - 25% of the remaining stake

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice, Open & Master

Note: AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship competition.

NOVICE CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places, with competition present, in a Novice class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

OPEN CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who have won three first place awards in a Novice class in a licensed or member show, with competition present. The winner of a Novice Class shall automatically become eligible, upon notice to the Open Class ring steward, to enter and compete in the Open Class at the same show provided the win is the 3rd first place award with competition and further providing there are one or more junior handlers competing in the Open Class.

MASTER CLASS: This class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 first place wins in an Open class with competition to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will be November 1 – October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed, all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year.

The Novice and Open Classes will be divided into **Junior, Intermediate and Senior** divisions.

The **Junior** class is for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show. The **Intermediate** class shall be for the boys and girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years on the day of the show.

The **Senior** class shall be for boys and girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

1. Show hours are 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.
2. Conditional, unsigned, or incomplete entries or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Telephone entries are not acceptable. All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies must include front and back of official AKC entry form.
3. All entries must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. institutions or with International Money Orders in U.S. funds. Credit cards cannot be accepted.
4. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.
5. Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing of entries, and must include AKC number of dog. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Substitutions require a new completed entry form.
6. Owners and owners' agents are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, except as provided for in AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
7. If it is impossible to open or to complete the show because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, or other acts beyond the control of the club, no refund of entry fee(s) will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, lightning, extreme heat or cold, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors, and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors, and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
8. Dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
9. All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club. Exhibitors are required to keep their areas clean. No grooming tables in the show area.
10. No private exercise pens are allowed inside the show building.
11. Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or owners' agents are solely responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring at the proper time. The club is not obligated to provide any service for notifying exhibitors of judging.

12. The show giving club and facilities owner, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, their children, etc., or to any of their dogs or property. Children are expected to be under the control of their parents or guardian.
13. There is no provision for un-entered dogs at this show. Only dogs that are AKC eligible are allowed on the show grounds.
14. All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. If not claimed, they revert back to the property of the club. No trophies will be mailed. The show giving club reserves the right to substitute trophies with ones of equal or greater value. Cash prizes will be presented to the handler of the dog.
15. Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering rings.
16. All exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their dogs!
17. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations. Wisconsin laws require dogs over 4 months of age to have current Rabies vaccination.

SETUP

The show site has ample grooming space. Setup of equipment will be permitted from 4:00 pm to 6:30 pm on Friday, March 12, but MAY be available earlier pending site setup completion by Club. The building will be available to exhibitors at 7:00 am on Saturday. Dogs are NOT permitted in the building overnight.

IMPORTANT: Tarps are required under your grooming area. If you do not have a tarp, a limited number of tarps will be available for purchase.

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST

Canine Good Citizen testing will be held at the show site on **Saturday, March 13, 2021**. Entry fee: \$15.00. Testing will take place during the lunch break between Specialty #1 and Specialty #2. Sign up before the conclusion of Specialty #1 on the day of the show. All dogs must be at least 6 months of age and AKC eligible. Contact Jerry Sulewski at (920) 833-2242 for additional information.

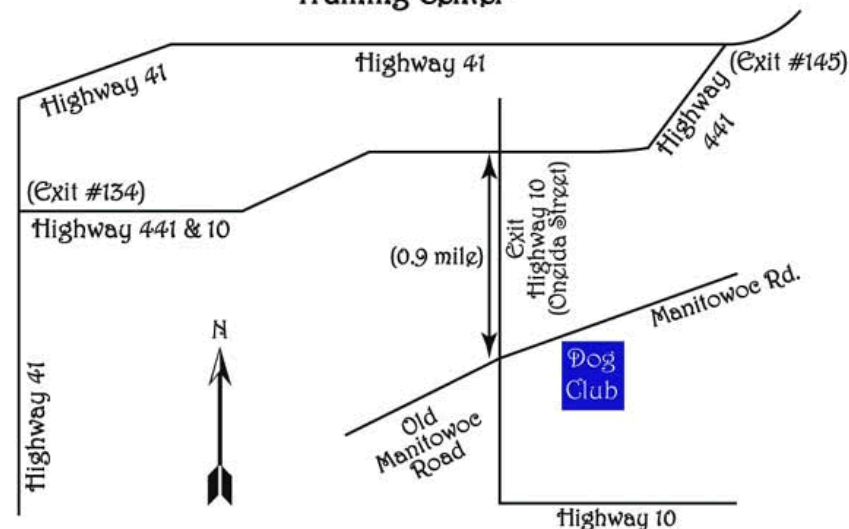
From South: I-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx. 30 miles to Menasha. At stoplights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd.) turn right. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From South (alternate route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge right over large bridge. Exit Oneida St., turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd, turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

Special Attraction – Pee Wee Class

When: Saturday, March 13, 2021

Time: During the Lunch Break between the Two Specialties

Entries: \$5.00 - - Day of Show (no pre-entry)

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is geared toward children 5–9 years of age. Children younger than five cannot participate in the Pee Wee Class Special Attraction. The safety of the children is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child, his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult, and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

- A dog must be at least four months of age to enter the Pee Wee class.
- Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.
- All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.
- A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring. The adult is to maintain control of the dog outside of the ring.
- At a Specialty Club Show the dogs must be of the breed(s) eligible for the event.
- In addition to an entry, a release must be signed by the child’s parent or legal guardian.

The safety of both the dogs and Juniors inside and outside the ring is a primary concern. Outside of the ring, the dog is to be controlled by the adult accompanying the child. At the Judge’s discretion based upon the size of the child and the dog, for safety purposes the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.

COVID-19 RULES

- If you are not able or willing to comply with all these stipulations, please do NOT enter these shows.
- Due to the ever-changing nature of COVID-19, all state, local and facility guidelines at the time of the show will be followed – even if they have not been published in this premium list.
- **Temperature checks will be performed upon entrance to the building. If you are ill, feel unwell, are coughing, sneezing or running a fever, please stay home. Anyone who enters the shows acknowledges that they will stay home if they are having any symptoms of COVID-19 and / or were knowingly exposed to someone with COVID-19.**
- **All persons entering the building will be required to sign a COVID-19 waiver.**
- These shows are closed to the general public. You must be entered or working at the show to be in the building.
- Everyone aged five (5) and older, will be required to wear a face mask (cloth or disposable) inside the building at all times. The face mask must be worn so that it covers your mouth and nose. If you are using a face shield, you must also wear a face mask. The following are NOT permitted: neck gaiters, open chin triangle bandanas or face masks with valves, vents, mesh material or holes of any kind. Requests for accommodation in accordance with the ADA must be submitted to the show chair prior to the show.
- You may remove your face mask while actively eating or drinking; however, you must be stationary and maintain appropriate physical distancing (6 feet). No eating or drinking will be permitted ringside.
- NWCC will NOT be providing masks. You must bring and wear your own mask, or you will not be permitted to enter the building.
- The use of a face mask is not a substitute for physical distancing (6 feet).
- Grooming spots will be spaced six (6) feet apart. Before setting up your grooming space, you must consult with a NWCC show committee member in the placement of your setup.
- No dryers or fans of any kind may be used inside the building.
- Exhibitors and attendees must bring their own chairs for the grooming area or ringside. No chairs will be provided.
- Exhibitors will be permitted to watch the show from ringside (seated or standing); however, must maintain social distancing between each other and from the ring. Anyone watching ringside will be responsible for following social distancing guidelines and must adhere to instructions from show committee members. Household units may sit together.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
