

- 1. Show hours are 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.
- Conditional, unsigned, or incomplete entries or entries received without fees will not be accepted. Telephone entries are not acceptable. All entries must be submitted on official AKC entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies must include front and back of official AKC entry form.
- 3. All entries must be submitted with checks drawn on U.S. institutions or with International Money Orders in U.S. funds. Credit cards cannot be accepted.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$30.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.
- 5. Entry form changes, additions, corrections, and cancellations must be received in writing prior to the closing of entries and must include AKC number of dog. Those received by telephone are not acceptable. Substitutions require a new completed entry form.
- 6. Owners and owners' agents are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible, except as provided for in AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellations received after the close of entries, nor in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- 7. - 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- 3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
- 4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name.
