JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice, Open, & Master

Note: AKC Junior Handler Numbers are required for entry in Junior Showmanship competition. Numbers may be obtained from the AKC: Phone (919) 233-9767

Novice Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who at the time entries close have not won three first places with competition present in a Novice class at a licensed or member show. Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present after the closing of entries for a show are required to transfer their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class by notifying the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the scheduled start of the Junior Showmanship judging at the show.

Open Class: This class shall be for boys and girls who at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Showmanship Class at a licensed or member show.

Master Class: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition. The calendar for this class will be consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to entry the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING

Briefing will be held one half hour (30 minutes) before the start of judging for each show. Please sign up at the Show Secretary Table.

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST

Canine Good Citizen testing will be held at the show site on Saturday, March 7. The entry fee is \$15.00. Testing will take place during the lunch break between Specialty #1 and Specialty #2. Sign up before the conclusion of Specialty #1 on the day of the show. All dogs must be at least 6 months of age and AKC eligible. Contact Jerry Sulewski at (920) 327-9641 for additional information.

SETUP INFORMATION

PEE WEE SPECIAL ATTRACTION – SATURDAY LUNCH BREAK

Entry Fee: \$5.00 - Entries taken day of show only

The Pee Wee Special Attraction is a Pre-Junior Showmanship class. The Pee Wee class is for children over 5 years & under 9 years of age. Safety is a primary concern.

Each Pee Wee unit consists of the child; his/her parent/guardian/responsible adult; and the dog. Only one Pee Wee unit is in the ring at a time. This is not a competitive class, but rather a fun, learning experience for the child and the adult.

The dog must be at least six months of age to be entered in the Pee Wee class.

Bitches in season will not be allowed to participate.

All dogs entered must have the proper lead and collar.

A responsible adult must be present with the child both inside and outside the ring.

The dog must be a Collie.

The safety of both dogs and Juniors inside and outside of the ring is a primary concern. Adult is to control the dog outside of the ring. At Judge's discretion and for safety purposes, the adult may be asked to attach a second lead to the dog so both child and adult will walk the dog together.


From South: I-43 North to West Hwy 10, go left. Follow Hwy 10 approx 30 miles to Menasha. At stoplights (Oneida St), turn right. At the next set of stop lights (Manitowoc Rd), turn right. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From South (Alternative route): Hwy 41 North to Exit 134 (Hwy 441 & 10), merge right over the large bridge. Exit Oneida St, turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd. Turn left. Dog club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

From West: Hwy 10 East, exit Oneida St. Turn right. Go south to stop lights at Manitowoc Rd. Turn left. Dog Club is 1/2 mile down this road on the right side.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- **Entry Fee shall not be refunded** in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of the show committee.
- **Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms** and photocopies of the entry form without the Agreement and Rules from the back of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.
- **Returned checks** do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$35.00 collection fee added to the amount of each returned check.
- **Owners and owners' agents** are responsible for any errors on entry forms, for entering the same dog twice or for entering a dog in a class for which it is not eligible for except as provided in AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Section 6.
- **If it is impossible to open or to complete** the show due to disturbances or other acts or conditions beyond the control of the club, no refund of entry fees will be made. The health and safety of the exhibitors, dogs and spectators must be considered.
- Dogs which according to their owners' records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show but whose champions are unconfirmed may be transferred from the regular class to Best of Variety competition provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary at least one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.
- All grooming must be done in areas specified by the club. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after themselves and their dogs and for keeping their areas clean. No grooming tables in show area.
- No private exercise pens are allowed inside the show building.
- Dogs must be ready for judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up class judging.
- The show giving club, facilities owners, and their agents and employees assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors, their children, their dogs or property. Children are expected to be under the control of their parent or guardian.
- Only dogs that are AKC eligible are allowed on the show grounds.
- All trophies must be claimed on the day of the show. If not claimed, they will revert back to the property of the club. No trophies will be mailed. The show giving club reserves the right to substitute trophies with ones of equal or great value. Cash prizes will be presented to the handler of dog.
- Please remember to turn off cell phones and/or pagers before entering ring.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free from parasites, communicable disease and have appropriate vaccines. Wisconsin law requires dogs over 4 months of age to have current Rabies Vaccine.
- Show hours are 11:00 am to 6:00 pm on Friday, March 6; 7:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturday, March 7; and 7:00 am to 3:00 pm Sunday, March 8.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
